
This list identifies all of the applicants who have made a combined visa who are required to undergo health examinations, to ensure they meet the requirements for an Australian 100 - PARTNER visa.

You need to do this separately for each member of the family who is listed on the letter.

Then answer all the questions truthfully!

- Bring the letter from the Department (ie. Health Examinations List) which we emailed you. It will be called “[your name].pdf”. You cannot see the doctors without this.
- And if the letter (the one above) includes your children (even if they are NOT migrating with you!), then will also need to have Medical examinations. You must do this!
- Bring your passport
- Bring your birth certificate
- Bring four (4) photocopies of your passport ID page
- Bring some extra ID (eg voters ID, postal ID) in case they ask.
- Bring 4 x passport photos (white or blue background)
- Bring any significant xrays or medical test results for previous conditions if applicable
- Current cost is around P4,250.00*. If they test for HIV, add P1,860.00*. Hepatitis, add P905.00*. We suggest you bring more money, as this may change.

If they ask you “what visa is this for?” or “Is this for a permanent visa or temporary visa?” If you are applying for a permanent visa (eg fiancée or spouse visa), then say “permanent”. If it’s a tourist visa only, say “temporary”. If you are applying for BOTH, say “permanent”. The visa type is written on the Health Examinations List letter anyway! **Be aware of the type of visa you are applying for, so you don’t need to panic and call us.**

And no, you do not need any forms! You will be attending an eHealth Clinic, which means the process is done electronically. ALL panel doctors in Philippines are eHealth Clinics. This symbol  means “eHealth”

Important!

1. **NB.** Ladies should not attend Medicals when it is “that time of the month”. Please wait until your menstrual cycle is finished.
2. **NB.** If you are pregnant, please discuss this with the doctor before getting an xray.
3. **NB.** Do not attend if you are sick, especially with any type of infection.

The results from your examination will go to the Department in Canberra. **YOU will not receive the results, and neither will we.** In fact even the Case Officers do not see the results. They will only receive instructions from Canberra. They MAY ask for further tests. If they do, you must follow their requests exactly, and respond quickly.
